

Here is some information about how we have decided as a church family to respond to the Covid 19 Protection Framework Policy – AKA The Traffic Light System and the use of My Vaccine Pass.

We are a group of people committed to following Jesus together. Jesus consistently looked out for & cared for those who were most vulnerable. For us this means children, the elderly, the immunocompromised, and those whose work could be very affected by infection with Covid.

In light of this, we have decided to ask people for their My Vaccine Pass if they would like to join with us on Sunday morning services at 10am.

Church isn't just about Sunday morning services though. We are also church when we're scattered all over town throughout the week. People are available and would be delighted to meet with anybody regardless of vaccine status. We also have groups that meet mid-week, and one of these is a place where people who do not have a My Vaccine Pass can gather.

We support and abide by Government policy in relation to Covid 19:

- We encourage people to be vaccinated
- We ask for My Vaccine Pass for Church related activities (bar one group)
- We ask for use of the Covid Tracer app or manual sign in
- We encourage mask wearing – noting that for those who really struggle with this to please use a mask as you can & remove it when you need to.

We are regularly reviewing these decisions and will communicate afresh after our next review.
