

Kia Ora whānau,

I love the cartoon on the back page of the newsletter. In it, Jesus looks in the mirror. What does Jesus see in the reflection? People. Lots of people. People who reflect Jesus themselves. People with different clothes, different facial expressions, different skin colours, different beliefs – people who are like Jesus in the way they reflect his kindness, love and compassion.

Let's remember to be kind, loving and compassionate to people, just as Jesus does. We're currently looking at some of the "One Another" passages in the Bible. There are 5 instructions in the New Testament on how to relate to one another.

As we continue to think about what it means to be church – committed in covenant partnerships with God and each other – how we relate with "one another" is hugely important.

Also, we are heading towards engaging again with the topic of marriage equality for the Rainbow community. As we open and study the Bible and discuss what this means for us today, these "one another" passages are ideally like the frame surrounding a piece of art. The frame ("one anothers") holds us together, provides boundaries for how we interact with each other, and in and of itself (how we relate to one another) can be an object of beauty and attraction.

Let's keep in the forefront of our minds these words:

Serve one another

Be at peace with one another

Clothe yourselves with humility towards one another

Love one another

Accept one another

And as the cartoon creator asks us to do – see Christ in one another – for we are all in Christ and Christ in us. With love.
